ANNIE BESANT'S BIRTHDAY MEETINGS

Vasanta Lodge TS Meeting on 30th September 2019 at Sis. Kalpanaben Jani's place: The Meeting was chaired by Dr. Ajay Hora. The Guest Speaker Bro. Bhavesh Pandya conducted deliberations on Gujarati Book translation of Dr. Annie Besant's book 'Path of Discipleship'.

At Blavatsky Lodge Joint Meeting of BTF & Blavatsky Lodge on 1st October 2019: The Meeting was opened with the Prayers of All Religions and the Universal Prayer. Bro. Navin Kumar in Opening spoke about multifaceted personality of Dr. Annie Besant. Sis. Jasmine Cawasji read out Dr. Besant's own words about her Parents and the values they had instilled in her.

Dr. Rajam Pillai spoke about Dr. Annie Besant's life journey of 'Storm to Peace' and the trauma she had gone through for being deprived of her children and many other things in the life. Yet she gave her life for the good of humanity. Her words were, 'I speak the Truth as I see it'. Even before she came to India she had said, 'India is my Motherland'.

BTF President Bro. Vinayak Pandya said AB believed that nothing is impossible. She was perfectionist, compassionate and cared to reply personally to all her mail. She treated servants as fellow human beings, who were there to help her in her life journey. For her cook even she built Hanuman Temple in Adyar. At the end of each year she would empty her coffer to help the needy.

Bro. Navin Kumar showed the downloaded Telecast of Door-Darshan Hindi film on 'Annie Wood Se Dr. Annie Besant Banena ka Safarnama'.

The meeting had ended with recitation of the Sanskrit Prayer.

THE WHITE DOG CAFÉ Bro. Arni Narendran shares story about Portrait of Madam Helena Petrovna Blavatsky at 'White Dog Cafe - Philadelphia. USA

When John Vidumsky, a Philadelphia based rowing reporter went to the first floor restaurant "The White Dog Café' he was intrigued to find the place steeped in History. In fact its owner, Judy Wicks, a west Philadelphia waitress who bought the place at 3420 Sansom street in the city's Ritten House Square, seventeen years ago, was concerned when someone knocked at her door one night and enquired whether it was the very house that Madam Blavatsky stayed 113 years ago. At that time she did not know either Madam Blavatsky or about Theosophy. But then, on finding a letter written by HPB about her gangrenous knee and how a White Dog that lay across her leg when she slept, brought about a miraculous cure. The Doctors had lost all hope and recommended to amputate. This miracle was also narrated by HPB to the iconic Irish Poet and Theosophist Y B Yeats. It was this incident that inspired Judy to name her restaurant – The White Dog Café.

Helena Petrovna Blavatsky in fact resided in this House in 1884. She had moved to investigate the séances of Nelson and Jennie Holmes, who later in life were found to be conning the public, faking two mediums John and Katie King, an old Spanish pirate and his pretty young daughter, whose graceful picture was a sellout and the monies collected were misused to buy a Horse and a Carriage. Initially though she was in support of them, subsequently on finding their fraud, she was forced to expose them to safeguard 'Spiritualism', which was gaining ground in America, with Philadelphia having as many as 300 odd members in this esoteric community. She described the Holmes as the biggest fraud of the age of spiritualists. In later years HPB stayed away from these séances, being aware of the pitfalls. HPB at that point of time was living with her short term husband, the whimsical Michael Betanally, a Businessman from Georgia. It was upon her divorce that she left for New York, where in 1875 she founded the Theosophical Society together with Col Henry Steel Olcott.

The restaurant is now popular with students and heritage seekers. On White Lotus Day, the Death anniversary of HPB, around fifty enthusiasts had gathered, Professors and students from the University of Pennsylvania, members of the Theosophical Society and Ms Marsha Siefert a concert pianist played the music of Alexander Scriabbin, a Theosophy inspired composer. As John Vidumsky remarks' though their numbers are few, Theosophists have an outsize influence on American culture as forerunners of the New Age Movement.
