

He introduced Shri Narendra Shah, General-Secretary of East & Central Africa Section, who on way back to Darussalam had graciously spared the evening for us. Bro. 

Bro. Arni Narendran on 25th January 2024 gave a talk on DEMYSTIFYING BLAVATSKY'S DRAWING OF MEDITATION. The talk was part of the FLAMING TORCH series initiated by Brandon Goh - coordinator of THE LOTUS CIRCLE. The collaborative effort with Ms. Clover Wu, the talk dwelled on the Historic background of the HPB technique which was imparted in the core Inner Circles of the Esoteric Section. A comparison with the Buddhist and Indian Yoga precepts on the subject helped one to understand better.

THE LOTUS CIRCLE is a dedicated Band of predominantly young Theosophists from Singapore, Philippines, India, and Holland, who

for the last four years have been working for channels for Planetary Healing through the MYSTIC ROSE RITUAL. Francis Lim introduced the Ritual on a global platform by conducting the Ritual during the recently concluded International Conference of the WORLD FEDERATION OF YOUNG THEOSOPHISTS (WFYT) at Advar in December 2023.

BLAVATSKY LODGE INERACTIVE SESSION WITH SWAMI SATHYANISHTANANDA

As announced earlier, our Blavatsky Lodge TS members had an interactive session with Swami Sathvanishtananda (earlier Bro. Janardana, Life Member of BL/TS) in our Green Room on 7th **February 2024.** The gist of what was transpired at the said session is enumerated here.

To set the tune, the session started with recitation of Sri Adi Shankaracharya's famous verses of Atma-Shatkam or Nirvana Shatkam by the Swamiji and he briefly explained its significance in spiritual practice of a Vedantic seeker.

As earnestly desired by the members, he narrated his spiritual journey, right from his childhood days in a rural place to serving as a senior executive in a large Central Government organization in and his association with few other social/spiritual organizations including Blavatsky Lodge TS, before his introduction to study of Vedanta at Sandeepany Sadhanalaya of Chinmaya Mission, Mumbai and subsequent initiation into the path of Sanvasa. He complimented the members of TS for their spiritual pursuits and their enthusiasm.

Presenting only the gist of Vedanta/Upanishadic teachings (Members of TS being advanced seekers and also due to timeconstraints), Swamiji explained that an individual is generally guided to the spiritual path when there is immense urge to know more about life and life's purpose and seeking for a peaceful life which is free from sorrows, inadequacies, fear and so on. The Upanishad or Vedanta, through a competent Guru, guides such an individual to conduct Self Enquiry – an enquiry involving Jeeva (Self), Jagat (Universe) and Jagadeeshwara (the absolute Master of the Universe). Such an enquiry eventually may lead the competent seeker to the understanding of essential Universal Oneness.

Universal Oneness means, despite perceiving countless varieties in the universe, in essence, they are all One Paramatma, which is of the nature of Existence-Consciousness. This firm understanding of Essential Oneness of the universe of countless names and forms trying to intelligently be understanding, while transacting with the prevailing manifoldness under all circumstances (i.e. Knowing and Being) is peace, free from all complaints and complexities.

In this regard, Swamiji explained one Mantra each from Chandogya Upanishad and Ishavasya Upanishad that reveal Universal Oneness. Universal Oneness means that there is only Paramatma, One Alone, and One without a Second, because of which everything is, the one that holds everything together, the one that pervades everything, the one which is substratum for everything, the one which is the substance/essence of all in this perceived universe of things and beings, though everything seems different from one another. The One who has not realized this Truth of Oneness, gives reality to each and everything, and the one who has realized this Truth and is grounded in that Knowledge, will see essential Oneness in all things and beings.


This aspect can be better understood with the help of a day-to-day **example of Hydrogen and Oxygen,** which are not perceivable, that become perceivable as Water, Ice, Steam and so on. Though water, ice, steam, etc. are seen different from one another with different natures of their own, which is different from the nature of Hydrogen

and Oxygen, there is nothing other than H&O in them. H&O appear in different forms with some names and thus a new world is perceived. The Scientist, who knows this Truth, sees H&O in and through all these forms and names, while the one who is ignorant of Chemistry sees them as different things.

Similarly, the one who has understood the Truth of Universe through scriptures with the help of Guru, **perceives essential**

oneness in the perceived world of plurality and remains in peace even while transacting in the world, while the ignorant one will see only plurality and suffers accordingly.

Swamiji explained that as indicated by the spiritual Masters, to comprehend this eternal Truth and transact in the world rooted in this Truth, it **requires a sustained and pure life, full of divine virtues like truthfulness, compassion, gratitude** and so on acquired in the process, which fact has also seemed to have been emphasized in the "At the Feet of the Master".

On February 4, 2024, at the Sir J. J. Boys & Girls School, Fort, Mumbai, TOS, Mumbai Region sponsored students had gathered to receive their Educational Aid Sponsorship Cheques. Besides the cheques, the children were gifted food items and stationery. One of their Ssponsors gave an extra donation to give a special treat to all the children covered by their project. One of their members arranged for pens to be distributed to the sponsored children. Additionally, TOS Gujarat Region sent us 300 notebooks that were also presented to the children this time. The disbursement activity had lasted for nearly three hours, and they had wound up the efforts by reciting the Universal Invocation written by the founder of TOS, Dr Annie Besant, and thanking the Higher Forces for Their guidance.

TOS, Mumbai Region President Sis. Thrity Dalal explaining the process of sponsorship says:

The Theosophical Order of Service (TOS) Mumbai Region has been rendering sponsorship assistance towards the education underprivileged children for over 50 years. Nearly 400 students selected by us receive sponsorship payments twice a year- February and July. The sponsored children are selected after verifying the

family's financial condition and the academic progress of the child. Each sponsor gives TOS a Minimum Annual sum of Rs Rs.5,000/-. A donor can give a lump sum of about Rs.1,00,000/- to invest and the interest earned on it to use for education of one child.

We are grateful to our benevolent sponsors, donors and members who support our efforts as also the band of committed volunteers who create time to liaise with the sponsored children and help out on the day of disbursement so that the work can be conducted seamlessly.

In 1922, The Adyar Committee was formed to raise funds for Adyar and to help with the construction of buildings. It is a Day to remember and give thanks to those who walked before us, who dedicated their lives to Theosophy and blessings of the very special gifts of Adyar."

Sis. Kashmira Khambatta, President Blavatsky Lodge remembered Col. Henry S. Olcott, Jiddu Krishnamurthy and Giordano Bruno who passed to the higher realms on this day and C.W. Leadbeater, who was born on this day.

She fondly remembered her mentor, **Sis. Khorshed Avari**, also born on 17th February, who had spread Theosophy with an artist's touch with self-prepared Charts and starting projection of slides on Theosophy.

PPt on Col. H. S. Olcott covered his memorable work of spreading Teachings of Lord Buddha in Sri Lanka, his books on Buddhism and the Stamp released in 1967 with his photo and Buddhist Flag designed by him.

PPt on J. Krishnamurti was based on pamphlet of Krishnamurti Foundation and the book 'Krishnamurti - the Years of Awakening' by Mary Lutyens. PPt traced JK's life from Birth, Childhood, mentoring by Annie Besant & C. W. Leadbeater, introduction to Theosophy, his Initiation in Astral Body & receiving Teachings to pen the book 'At

the Feet of the Master', formation of the Order of the Star of the East, J. K.'s Resignation and JK's Teachings with his insight into the human condition and his vision for the sacred.

PPt on Giordano Bruno stated that Giordano Bruno was an Italian Philosopher, Cosmological Theorist and Poet. In Rome he was imprisoned for 7 years and was sentenced to death in year 600 for speaking Truth that 'the Earth is Round'. He was burnt alive, but his words were, 'I did not fear death and preferred a brave death instead of a life of an idiot.'

On this auspicious Day **Diploma was presented to** Blavatsky Lodge member **Bro. Ramesh Balkrishna Rao Deshpande** by BTF Officers Bro. Taral Munshi & Sis. Mahazaver Dalal and Blavatsky Lodge President Sis. Kashmira Khambatta.
