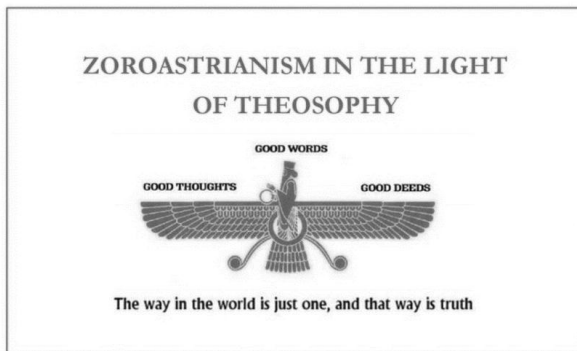

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**BOMBAY THEOSOPHICAL FEDERATION**  
**THE 89TH ANNUAL ONLINE SESSION**  
**16th & 17th October 2020 at 6.00 pm on Zoom**

The 89th Annual Session of Bombay Theosophical Federation was unique. It was a Virtual Session on Zoom with vibrancy of Brethren of Bombay energized with of **Brotherhood warmth of Brethren from Adyar, Indian Section, South India, Philippines, Singapore, Pakistan and East & Central Africa**. BTF members Sis. Kashmiri Khambatta and Sis. Aban Patel joined even from Lonavala.

BTF 89th Annual Session was **graced by Shri. N. C. Krishna, National Lecturer** as the Chief Guest. The theme of the Annual Session given by the Chief Guest was '*Vitalizing Theosophy and The Theosophical Society*'

**This Online Session was hosted & conducted by BTF President Bro. Vinayak Pandya helped by Bro. Taral Munshi helped him.**

**OPENING SESSION ON 16TH OCTOBER 2020**

The Opening Session attended by 47 Brethren had 18 Invitees from India & Abroad. Singapore Lodge had very kindly changed their meeting date to join BTF Opening Session.

BTF President Bro. Vinayak Pandya with welcome words requested **Bro. Arni Narendran to recite the Universal Prayer. Bro. Berthram Redwood starting with an Invocation conveyed the Greetings of:** International Vice-president Dr. Deepa Padhi, International lecturers Prof. C. A. Shinde & Shri Agnihotri, Indian Section Ex-General Secretary Shri S. Sundaram & Manjuji, National lecturer & UP-UK Federation President Shri U. S. Pandey, Delhi Federation President Shri Rajiv Gupta, TOS Mumbai Region President Sis. Thrity Dalal, and East & Central Africa Section General Secretary Shri Narendra Shah. International Representative for Pakistan Bro. Mushtak Jindani conveyed Greetings in person.

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**Sis. Thrity Dalal speaking about TOS activities in Mumbai** said that under Pandemic Education Grant to 500 students was given with direct deposits in their bank accounts. Virtual Healing Ceremony was held invoking peace and health for all. Once a year a training camp is held in Deolali mainly for youngsters to learn Theosophical Teachings.

**Sis. Thrity Dalal introducing the Chief Guest** said it was her privilege to introduce Dear Friend Shri N. C. Krishna whom she knew since 1975 when they used to meet at International Conventions in Adyar. He joined TS when he was 16yr and today he is the National Lecturer. He is from a small town of Andhra Pradesh and was brought up by the inspiration of his mentor Maternal Grandfather Shri M. Krishna ma Charyulu, who was Joint General Secretary of Indian Section in Seventies and National lecturer. Academically, after graduation in Commerce he qualified as Chartered Accountant. CA Vinayak Pandya complemented him as '*A CA in true sense with great integrity*'. He wants to be remembered as '*who tried and one who has led a Theosophical life*'.

**Chief Guest Shri N. C. Krishna in his Address on 'Vitalizing Theosophy and The Theosophical Society'** said: It is necessary to vitalize age old Wisdom, which is even older than man. Theosophy is not well defined. One can say it is Wisdom processed by Godly person. Man has innate potential to realize Divinity within him.

### **How to Vitalize Theosophy?**

**"We are talking about God with small 'g',** which man is capable of realizing to arrive at the gate of Divinity. As a nurtured sapling grows into a big tree, a seed of Theosophy sprouted in man with effort, commitment, zeal, enthusiasm & conviction leads him to Divinity. **Theosophy a Path to treadfor Perfection is not just for self, it is for good of others. Progress on the path depends on person's study, understanding, contemplation and internal realization of Theosophical Teachings.**

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Gathered knowledge has to be processed to turn into Wisdom, like churning of curd to get butter – the Essence. With Internalized wisdom and right type of life one must work for humanity. **Wisdom has to be applied with altruism and unselfishness. Weeds of selfishness have to be removed.**

**Pythagorean School students studied** with the master for 12 years. First two years they had to just listen, study, and meditate. They could not seek clarification as clarification comes after introspection & contemplation.

**For a member of TS,** Theosophy is taken as a seed within guiding one **to live for others with concern.** Founders of TS have gone through hardship and with great effort have propagated Theosophy. Theosophy is for the masses and not for a chosen few. Hence one has to work for Oneness – Unity.”

### **How to vitalize Theosophical Society?**

“To propagate Theosophy, one does not have to compete in Spiritual field. One has to compete with oneself. **Do we remember to renew our membership?** In India in 1920 there were about 27,000 members. Today Indian Section membership is around 11,000. **Lodges must be activated, and second line prepared to pass Baton for continuity of Lodge vibrancy. *Lodge is a Temple of Learning.*** One should attend Lodge Meetings with determination of a soldier and not when it is convenient. Individual Study and group Study both are important.

We should go to the doorstep of schools & colleges for students & teachers and to Corporate. Conduct workshops on ‘Daily Theosophical Life’ for students at Lodges. Write & print easy to read small books on Theosophy.

**Sharing his Rayalaseema Theosophical Federation’s work** he said, “Federation covers 2 schools/2 colleges every month. They encourage ‘Speakers Club’ of students to debate on concerned issues. Show

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videos to encourage students to interact. At such events pamphlets, placards, bookmarks, small 70 page booklets and information about Theosophy is given to students. Values of ‘*New Life of India*’ and ‘*Build Better Citizens*’ have to be encouraged, but not to indulge in politics. Theosophy should be conveyed in simple words. Follow up efforts brings results.”

**Under Pandemic his Federation has started** First Virtual Lodge.147 Members were added. Four new Lodges were formed. Membership increased from 500 to 750 members.

**With 145 years on 17th November 2020, Theosophical Society is one oldest organization working for humanity.** We will have to move out of our comfort zones. Though for TS it is quality and not quantity of members, but without giving opportunity quality will not be found. Like shoot of great Banyan Tree at Adyar shoots of TS should be strong to for TS to withstand over ages.

**TS should become relevant to address challenges of time.** Our Founders had talked to the West about what is needed more than materialism. They were encouraged to study Eastern Wisdom.

**The Two Wise Masters** wanted to conduct an experiment for the good of humanity. They had to work through suitable selfless persons and so they chose the Founders Madam H. P. Blavatsky and Col. H. S. Olcott.

**In a TV interview the Anchor was concerned** that TS membership has come down and expressed that Theosophy and Theosophical Society are need of the time. The answer is in members’ attitude, i.e to live Theosophical Life useful for others. A member should resolve that ‘I shall not live, but my work lives. My life should reflect what Theosophy and Theosophical Society represent, even in my daily life.”

**Shri N. C. Krishna fondly remembered his association with Brethren of Bombay.** He recollected a play written by Bro. Rusi Toddywalla in which he, Sis. Thrity Dalal and Sis. Deepa Kapur with

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other young members had acted at the TS Centennial Convention at Adyar.

**In response to Bro. Navin Kumar's question**, he said it is good to begin with members from home. Future of TS depends on children of members.

**Sis. Zeena Rastomjee proposed the Vote of Thanks.** The Opening Session ended with recitation of **Sanskrit Prayer by Bro. Navin Kumar.**

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### **CLOSING SESSION ON 17TH OCTOBER 2020**

The Closing Session attended by 40 Brethren had 9 Invitees from USA, Turkey, England, Finland, South India, Philippines, and Singapore. The Virtual Centre for Theosophical Studies was represented by The Founder Director: Bro Luke Michael Ironside and young Bro. Tony Vale.

**Bro. Arni Narendran** introduced members of The Virtual Centre for Theosophical Studies. He said, Philippines has become an epic centre for Theosophical Studies with youth of Philippines under pandemic. VCTS was founded with support and encouragement of International President Tim Boyd and International Secretary Ms Marja **The 89th Annual General Meeting of Bombay Theosophical Federation was conducted with Power Point Presentation by President Bro. Vinayak Pandya. 29 Members had joined for the AGM.** All points of Agenda were presented on screen and the business was conducted. President's proposal to continue with same BTF Council under Pandemic for next two-year Term of 2020-2022 was unanimously passed. Resolutions for International & Indian Section Leaders and Dedicated Brethren who cannot attend due to old age and health were passed.

### **SHORT TALKS**

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**Sis. Thrity Dalal introduced the Chief Guest Shri N. C. Krishna, who chaired the Short Talks and the Speakers. Dr. Ajay Hora, Stalwart of Bombay TF, who grew up with and lived Theosophy. He has nurtured BTF as President over two decades. He has addressed Annual Sessions of Gujarat and Marathi Federations. He is on committees of many institutions to reach out to needy. Bro. Arni Narendran** a prominent Banker has interest in Journalism, Art, History and Wellness Meditation of the Paramahansa Yogananda Linage and has grown up with Theosophy serving at Adyar from a young age. He is Treasurer and Lecturer of Blavatsky Lodge, conducts meditation and is now Education Director of VCTS.

**Bro. Arni Narendran's Talk  
on 'Virtual Platform for Theosophy'**

For the benefit of Invitees first he told them fascinating facts about how Founders HPB & HSO had come to Bombay and had founded Blavatsky Lodge 140 years ago.

Bro. Arni elaborated on **the story of the Virtual Centre of Theosophical Studies (VCTS)** and how it forms the third phalanx namely through a group of vitalized individual members. Each individual member is the critical factor in the discourse, and it is a remarkable story of how such individuals have established the new Platform.

**VCTS**, though supported by Int President Tim Boyd and Int Secretary Marja Artamaa, is not part of the Adyar infrastructure and remains **an independent self-operating platform of the Adyar Theosophical Society**. Not attached to any Federation or National Section. **The Founder Director: Bro Luke Michael Ironside**, all of twenty-six summers is a new star in the Theosophical horizon. Jerome Guamagay describes Luke as 'A Theosophist with a missionary zeal'. Luke hails from Guernsey, a small island on the Normandy coast off Great Britain. Bro. Arni also spoke about other key members of VCTS.



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Back home in Mumbai, he introduced Sis. Meherangiz Baria, Past President/Secretary and Librarian of the Blavatsky Lodge. She was working in the corporate sector but resigned to serve in the social service domain. She has been instrumental in providing content on VCTS new initiative.

‘The Wisdom Capsule’ series is a multimedia Theosophy content platform initiative of VCTS to diffuse Theosophy through videos, podcast, webinars, PPT, Print and e- publications and various other mediums. VCTS is thankful to the Bombay Theosophical Federation for launching the first in the series of ‘Wisdom Capsule’.

**Bro. Arni Narendran, Education Director of VCTS requested BTF President Bro. Vinayak Pandya to launch WISDOM CAPSULE Project** for multi-media platform. Special beautiful slide announced the **Launch of Wisdom Capsule with the First Capsule on ‘Zoroastrianism in Light of Theosophy’**. The Research and content of this first Capsule is by **Sis. Meherangiz Baria**, Past President of Blavatsky Lodge. The Capsule is conceived and produced by Bro. Arni Narendran, Meherangiz **Baria had the privilege to show PPT of the capsule.**

### **DR. Ajay Hora’s Talk on ‘Living Theosophy’**

Dr. Ajay Hora with 78 years growing in and living Theosophy said it is not easy to vitalize Theosophy and The Theosophical Society. He quoted the guidelines of great Theosophists, like – ‘Be a lamp to oneself’, ‘Let him understand darkness, helplessness they are passing through to lift heavy Karma.’ However, there is compassion. He narrated CWL’s two stories about Invisible helpers. Theosophy gives Freedom of thought, freedom of worship and freedom from fear. There has to be complete dedication to work for God’s Plan. One should work for what is best for the whole world and not just for oneself.

Dr. Ajay Hora shared personal experiences of Theosophical life right from his birth. At the time of his birth his mother’s health was in

danger. But Mother had said ‘I am going to give birth to a Theosophist child so not to worry’ and he was born on White Lotus day with Mother and baby both in good health. From age of five he has been blessed to be in touch with International Presidents, starting with President G. S. Arundale.

Dr. Ajay Hora fondly remembered stalwarts of Bombay and their dedication. He regretted that the BTF Annual Session could not be held at Juhu due to pandemic. After serving BTF over two decades he has passed the Baton to Bro. Vinayak Pandya. He requested all to take care of and vitalize Bombay Theosophical Federation. He ended with Best Wishes to entire TS in the World.

**Bro. Navin Kumar**, could not attend due to ill health, but had sent Messages, which were conveyed by Bro. Vinayak Pandya.

The BTF 89th Annual Session with memorable experience ended with **Vote of Thanks by Sis. Zeena Rastomjee** and recitation of **Sanskrit Prayer by Bro. Arni Narendran**.

**DR. ANNIE BESANT'S BIRTHDAY MEETING**  
*On 1st October 2020*

**BTF & Blavatsky Lodge Joint Virtual Meeting**

**Bro. Navin Kumar as the Host** welcomed all to pay devotion to Dr. Annie Besant as is every year done in Besant Hall. Blavatsky Lodge President **Sis. Kashmiri Khambatta** recited The Universal Prayer. She spoke about Annie Besant's life devoted to Theosophy.

**Sis. Aban Patel** read Shri Madan Mohan Malavia's tributes to Annie Besant for her magnanimity to gift Central Hindu College for formation of Banaras Hindu University and her unstinted work for India.

**Sis. Meherangiz Baria** read Annie Besant's words on Theosophical Society, Study of Theosophy and Admission of Members.

**Bro. Arni Narendran** said that Blavatsky Lodge owes a lot to Annie Besant. She had donated British Pounds 1,000/- for Blavatsky Lodge Building. The Opening Ceremony of the Building was by her. She had given lectures in Besant hall overflowing with listeners. Even Mohammad Ali Jinnah used to attend her lectures. The first book of 'Geeta' Mahatma Gandhi read was of Annie Besant.

**Sis. Mahazaver Dalal** paid homage to AB for her magnanimity and love for her Motherland India, by reading her answer to people who were telling her not to give away the college: *'We have built the Central Hindu College to serve the Indian Nation and if the Nation's welfare requires our extinction, we must not grudge the sacrifice.'*

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Sis. Mahazaver urged that AB's guidelines for Right Citizenship and use of Thought Power should be guiding lights for TS members.

**Bro. Berthram Redwood** spoke about Divinity of Christ and HPB encouraging AB to Esoteric Christianity.

**Bro. Zinoo Master** said AB was loyal to 'Truth' till the end of her life. A person who can write so much is miraculous. Her

courage to withstand trauma of life is remarkable. She was a 'Multifaceted Diamond'.

**Sis. Deepa Kapur** said that for Kiran Bedi AB was her life inspiration.

**Bro. Navin Kumar** in the closing said that AB was a True Yogi. She did everything in a perfect way. Her translation of Geeta is the best. He ended the meeting with recitation of Sanskrit Prayer.

***Annie Besant's Birthday Meeting at Adyar  
Attended by Bombay Brethren***

**Thanks to kind invitation of International Lecturer Shri Shikhar Agnihotri, BTF Brethren had a rare experience of attending Adyar Virtual Meeting to celebrate Dr. Annie Besant's Birthday from their own homes in Bombay.** It was a **great feeling of Brotherhood** with 250-300 Brethren joining from 25 countries. **Sis. Katelina Shikhar had hosted** the meeting in Adyar – The Masters' Home.

The program was opened with **the Universal Prayer, which was written by Annie Besant in 1923** for Brotherhood, Peace & Harmony.. **International Secretary Ms Marja Artamaa** in welcoming all said for 40 years AB lived in her Homeland India. She is alive and visible with many schools & institutions founded by her. Her statue on Marina Beach is a reminder for what she wanted for India.

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**International President Tim Boyd in his Inaugural Address** spoke highly about her achievements. Some of the observations were: Dr. A.B. was a dreamer, writer, orator, and organizer, and above all a great spiritual person. Her profound practicality is admired most for expanding and developing the Theosophical Society communities in India and at many places in the world. She purchased land, built buildings, colleges, created assets and even gifted them. In 1907 when she became the President of The Theosophical Society at Adyar, they had 27 acres of land but by the time she left, the Society possessed 253 acres.

She believed in spirituality and said ‘let our spirituality be seen by all’. On the premises of Adyar campus she built schools and residential places for the staff and the guests who came from all over the world. She made Adyar an active hub of creativity and knowledge.

She was a visionary. She purchased land at Ojai in California and said that Ojai will become cradle of new civilization in America. She named this place Happy Valley because from a barren place it became a beautiful orchard of fruit trees. She believed that education must be fourfold – health and evolution of body, mind, and creativity. As a visionary she found ways to translate these dreams in reality.

**Sis. Jayashree Kanan** with her sweet voice sang a song on A.B. **International Treasurer Ms Nancy Secrest** speaking on ‘*There is No Other*’ highlighted founding of Theosophical Order of Service (TOS) by A.B. and work of TOS for education, health, ecology and other worthy causes all over the world. Altruism for suffering of others, Compassion, Unlimited Love, Humanitarian Help and Harmlessness are driving forces for TOS. TOS is Theosophy in Action.

**International lecturer Prof. C. A. Shinde** in his talk on ‘*The Embodiment of Impersonality*’ elaborated on A.B.’s great work for her Motherland India. There is not a field where she did not work to

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‘Wake up India’ with Right Citizenship (Duty), Right Values (Ethics) Right Means (correct action). She built National Spirit, worked for Women Empowerment, against Cast System, Dowry & Child Marriage, preparing young speakers to work for Self-Government from village to Parliament levels, etc. Her Home Rule League has paid great role in India’s Independence movement. She brought Scouting to India, for which she was given highest award of ‘Silver Wolf’. For A.B., ‘To me there is no other country like India for me’. In the Light of the Truth she lived, died and lives on.

**Head of Editorial Ms. Clemices Pettar** in her talk on ‘AB’s Great Legacy’ spoke about A.B. giving World Teacher J. Krishnamurthy to the World. AB used to tell JK, ‘I want to learn from you. You are my Teacher.’ This was her humbleness.

**Video with AB’s quotes** was inspiring. **Shri Shikhar Agnihotri in Vote of Thanks** said that though physically apart, together in heart & mind all had united. All were invited to recite **Sanskrit Prayer** with will & thought power, which was displayed on screen in different languages.
